

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Pathways Coordinator Becky Ethelbah has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve Pathways manuscript for publication: Nutrient Content of School Meals in Elementary Schools on Indian Reservations: Baseline Findings from the Pathways Study; and

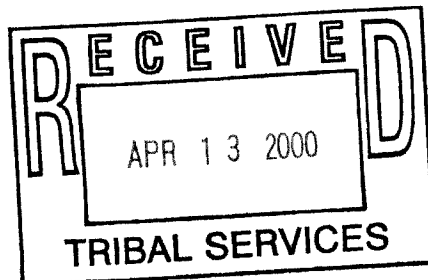
WHEREAS, this report represents data on the nutritional adequacy of school meals offered to American Indian students in reservation schools and to compare the nutrients provided in school meals with the Recommended Dietary Allowances (RDA's) and national recommendations for dietary fat; and

WHEREAS, this manuscript examines data collected as part of the baseline Pathways Study. Data is collected from the forty-one (41) schools that participated in the Pathways Study.


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it should grant approval to have this manuscript published.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves publication of Pathways manuscript, "Nutrient Content of School Meals in Elementary Schools on Indian Reservations: Baseline Findings from the Pathways Study.

The foregoing resolution was on March 31, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
