## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. and Mrs. Armondo Henry have requested that their adopted daughter, Tamara Lynn Henry, be enrolled with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Tamara Lynn Henry's (DOB: 06/01/93) enrollment application with supporting required documents; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee finds that Tamara Lynn Henry is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Ms. Henry possesses the necessary blood quantum required under the Tribal Constitution and Enrollment Code.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Tamara Lynn Henry's request for enrollment into the White Mountain Apache Tribe based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment committee, subject to recission pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code, Sections 1-202(a) and 1-704

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 19, 2000</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II and Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
