

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

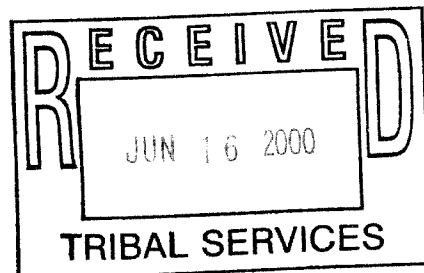
**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Joel and Glenda V. Hernandez have requested that their adopted daughter, Jaryn Jenee Hernandez be enrolled with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Jaryn Jenee Hernandez's (DOB: 02/25/83) application with supporting required documents; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Enrollment Committee finds Jaryn Jenee Hernandez is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum required under the Tribal Constitution and Enrollment Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Jaryn Jenee Hernandez's request for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, subject to rescission pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code, Sections 1-202(a) and 1-704.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II and Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
