

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

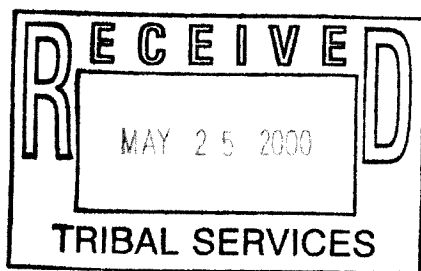
- WHEREAS**, Tribal member Dustinn Craig has come before the Tribal Council with a proposal to coordinate a skate board competition for the community to be held on or about August 12, 2000; and
- WHEREAS**, local competitions have been held in prior years, however, the ramps and other equipment for the competition are in need of replacement; and
- WHEREAS**, Mr. Craig has proposed the construction of new ramp equipment along with funding for community outreach and sponsor solicitation for the upcoming skateboard competition; and
- WHEREAS**, Mr. Craig has suggested that the HonDah Casino parking lot may be an appropriate location for the skateboard competition; and
- WHEREAS**, Mr. Craig would coordinate the event and supervise the construction of the ramps and other equipment for the competition, and also coordinate the fund raising, public relations, and videotape recording of the events; and
- WHEREAS**, Mr. Craig has submitted a budget to the Tribal Council in the amount of \$17,000, as attached herein for producing this event; and
- WHEREAS**, following the competition, the skateboard equipment and ramps will be available for other community use; and
- WHEREAS**, a responsible community group or Tribal group could be charged with the maintenance and safeguarding of the skateboard equipment for future use; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council recognizes the benefits of well organized skateboard competitions as an outlet for our youth; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council encourages Mr. Craig to seek funding assistance and cooperation from other community organizations and Tribal departments, including the HonDah Casino.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request by Mr. Dustinn Craig for the 5th Annual Skateboard Competition to be held on or about August 12, 2000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the budget request in the amount of \$17,000 submitted by Mr. Craig for the preparation and work necessary to undertake the skateboard event, and for that purpose the Tribal Council also directs Mr. Craig to seek the cooperation and financial assistance of Tribal departments and community groups for this event to help fund the \$17,000 amount.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs Mr. Craig to work with the Tribal Business Office for the authorization of partial payments as set forth in the budget, providing the necessary documentation and justification for the expenditures as those expenses come due.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it requests that Mr. Craig identify in a later report to the Tribal Council the final location and date for the annual skateboard event and to make any recommendations which he may have for the Council consideration concerning the ongoing management and custody of the skateboard equipment and later planning of further skateboard events for the youth of our community.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
