FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Holy Ground members of the Tribe have come before the Tribal Council this date and requested land area in Fort Apache; and

WHEREAS, the members related that they have experienced conflicts in current area (Seven Mile Jr.); and

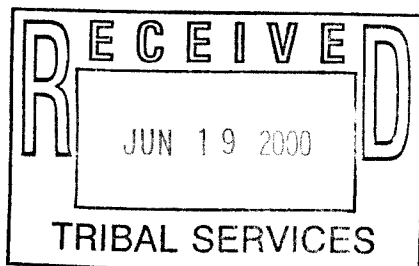
WHEREAS, the group feels that this new area will be beneficial to all involved as well as halting conflicts; and

WHEREAS, the group are advised to follow the land application process as mandated by the Tribal Land Office; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports the Holy Ground members in their request as they offer traditional healing ceremonies and understand the group's need for a permanent site for this purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to the Holy Ground members for site indicated near Fort Apache for purpose and hereby provides its support for an application to the Land Office.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
