WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council in Resolution 03-2000-80, dated March 8, 2000 approved and endorsed the three day Native Vision Sports and Life Skills Camp 2000 to be held at Fort Apache; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Mariddie Craig has described for the Tribal Council some of the plans and preparations for this important youth event; and

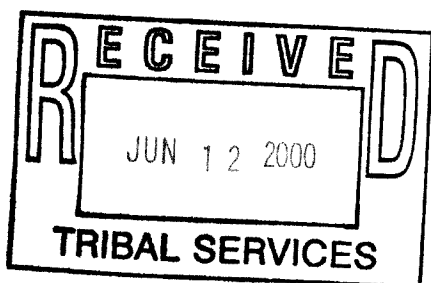
**WHEREAS**, there are many resources within our community which can add to the quality of this event; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council recognizes the long term value of bringing together interested people to promote the interests of our youth.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby encourages all tribal programs and other community organizations to participate in and support the three day Native Vision Sports and Life Skills Camp 2000 to be held June 9, 10, and 11 at Fort Apache.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby allocates \$5,000 in tribal funds to be made available for the miscellaneous and unanticipated expenses incurred during the three day event, such funds to be expended by the Tribal Business Office upon receipt of acceptable documentation to verify the need and the amount of the expenditure.

The foregoing resolution was on May 18, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k) (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
