FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, John Beeler has come before the Tribal Council to seek support for his effort to be elected to the Justice of the Peace position; and

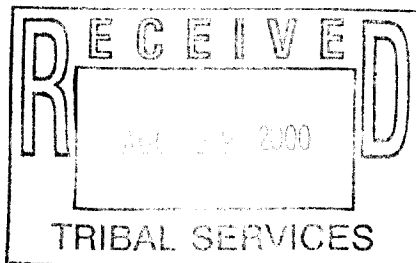
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has already endorsed Cheryl Martin for the upcoming general election for the Justice of the Peace; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Beeler requests Tribal Council endorsement in the upcoming Republican primary election for the Justice of the Peace position; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs to support and endorse Mr. Beeler for the stated position.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and endorses the candidacy of John Beeler for the Justice of the Peace position in the upcoming Republican primary election and grants him permission to post political signs on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
