**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribe is represented by leaders who are elected by voters; and

**WHEREAS,** there are minimum of 7,432 registered voters within the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribe is poised to enter the new millennium faced with challenges which affect the health and welfare of its citizens and it is incumbent upon the voters to select leaders who have the leadership capability, integrity and energy to work on these issues; and

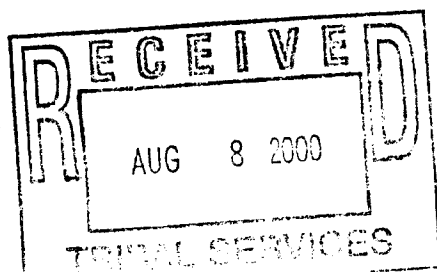
**WHEREAS,** the right to cast your vote is considered to be sacred and time honored in the tradition of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the right to vote is protected by the Tribal Constitution, the Indian Civil Rights Act and the United States Constitution; and


**WHEREAS,** the National General Election is scheduled for November 07, 2000 to elect the various elected offices of the State of Arizona, as well as National Leaders; and

**WHEREAS,** it is incumbent upon all employers of the White Mountain Apache people to provide ample time for their White Mountain Apache employees to travel to cast their votes in their registered precincts.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declares the week of August 7 – August 11, 2000 as Voter Awareness Week and call upon all White Mountain Apache Tribal Members to register to vote and exercise their vote by casting their ballot for the candidate of their choice in the November 07, 2000 National General Election.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
