FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

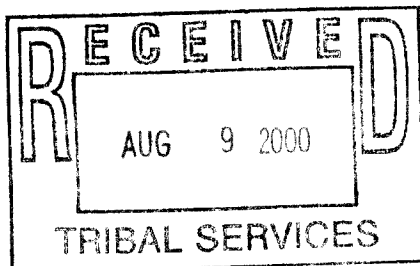
WHEREAS, Becky Ethelbah on behalf of Johns Hopkins University Pathways has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve proposed study: Lifetime Health for Preschool American Indian Children; and


WHEREAS, the goal is to teach healthy lifetime habits and prevent overweight in American Indian Preschool Children enrolled in Head Start Centers, serving the White Mountain Apache Indian Tribe. By a culturally appropriate school based intervention program designed to promote healthy eating behaviors, increase physical activity and involve the family/community; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it should grant approval and will participate in this study which will benefit tribal members.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Johns Hopkins University to implement a study: Lifetime Health for Preschool American Indian Children; to teach healthy lifetime habits and prevent overweight in American Indian preschool children enrolled in Head Start Centers serving the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
