RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Becky Ethelbah on behalf of Johns Hopkins University Pathways has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve for publication the Pathways manuscript, Body Composition and Obesity Prevalence in American Indian School Children Enrolled in the Pathways Study; and
- WHEREAS, this report describes the body composition and anthropometric characteristics of school children from seven American Indian communities enrolled in the Pathways study. These results document the remarkably high prevalence of obesity in American Indian youth; and
- WHEREAS, this manuscript examines data collected as part of the baseline Pathways study.

 Date is collected from the 41 schools that participated in the Pathways study; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it should grant approval to have this manuscript published.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves publication of Pathways manuscript, <u>Body Composition and Obesity Prevalence in American Indian School Children enrolled in the Pathways Study.</u>

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 2, 2000</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
