RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes that one of its greatest assets is its children; and
- WHEREAS, Rupert Lupe and Gertie Lupe have advised the Council of the schedule of events for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair and Rodeo Junior Rodeo competition and of the need for appropriate prizes and recognition for the Rodeo; and
- WHEREAS, Rupert Lupe and Gertie Lupe have advised the Council that they need \$1,500 to fund such prizes and recognition.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Controller and the Tribal Finance Committee to appropriate Tribal funds where possible to donate \$1,500 to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Fair and Rodeo Junior Rodeo competition.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 2, 2000</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
