RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Gary Butler has come before the Tribal Council to seek support for his effort to be elected as the Navajo County Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Butler's request and endorses him for stated position.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and endorses the candidacy of Gary Butler as the Navajo County Sheriff and grants him permission to post political signs on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 3, 2000</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
