

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

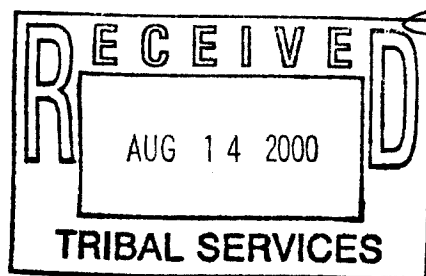

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the U.S. Postal Service has requested a renewal of the Whiteriver Post Office lease, which expires January 31, 2002; and
- WHEREAS, the Postal Service requests a renewal of the Whiteriver Post Office Lease for a term of five years, beginning February 1, 2002 and ending January 31, 2007, at an annual rent of \$23,278.00; and
- WHEREAS, a BIA appraisal of the leased premises has been conducted, and lease negotiations between the Tribal Legal Department and the U.S. Postal Service have been completed; and
- WHEREAS, the U.S. Postal Service has submitted a proposed lease, based upon negotiations with the Tribal Legal Department and requests Tribal Council approval of said lease documents; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered this request and believes continued postal services in Whiteriver would be in the best interest of the community and its residents.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of the U.S. Postal Service for a renewal of the Whiteriver Post Office Lease, for an additional term of five years beginning February 1, 2002 and ending January 31, 2007, at an annual rental of \$23,278.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman or any other authorized representative, to sign any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 3, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
