
RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received a request from Myrtle Bragg, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and her husband Joe Bragg to extend their ability to operate their vehicle towing business known as Twin Rivers Towing; and
- WHEREAS, Myrtle and Joe Bragg have previously received a one year business operating license to operate Twin Rivers Towing within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, Myrtle and Joe Bragg have this day requested the Tribal Council's approval to assume the obligations and responsibilities of a 15 year business lease for their current business site on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council endorses the ownership and operation of businesses within the Reservation by Tribal Members.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that it hereby directs the Legal Department to draft, negotiate and finalize a business lease agreement between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Myrtle Bragg on the same terms and conditions as other business leases
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman or in his absence the Vice Chairman, and the Superintendent of the Bureau of Indian Affairs to enter into a business lease with Myrtle Bragg for Twin Rivers Towing.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 21, 2000</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
