- **WHEREAS**, they have requested financial assistance in the amount of \$800.00 to help defray traveling expenses.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves financial assistance in the amount of \$800.00 to assist Lenea Lupe as she competes in Hawaii.
