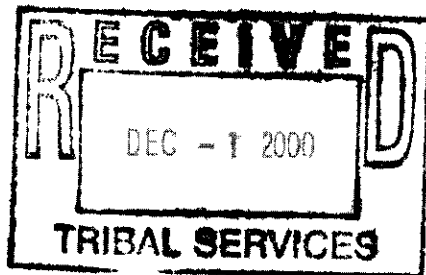
**RESOLUTION OF THE


