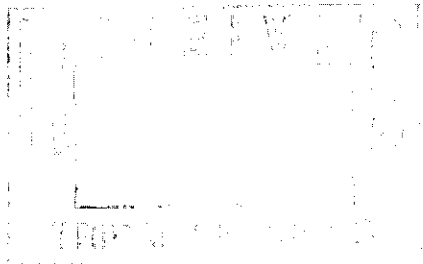
**RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** participants in the local annual Women's Conference are currently granted four (4) hours administrative leave; and

**WHEREAS,** the Health Board Chairperson, Mariddie Craig, has informed the Tribal Council of the Board's recommendation to grant eight (8) hours administrative leave for participants in the Women's Conference as this is considered part of their career development.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants eight (8) hours administrative leave to participants in the Women's Conference as recommended by the Health Board.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
