

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has heard the request of Elaine Ethelbah for assistance with repairing the sewer lines at her home in Whiteriver; and

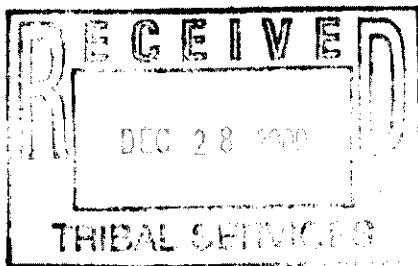
WHEREAS, Ms. Ethelbah has advised the Tribal Council that the condition of her sewer lines has caused her great concern and risk to her health and the health of her family and elderly mother; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Ethelbah has requested assistance with her sewer line problem from Tribal Utility Authority for several years previous to coming to the Council, without results; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jimmy Brownfeather of the WMAT Utility department advised the Council that he will be able to assign his staff to help remedy Ms. Ethelbah's sewer line problems as soon as they are finished with their current project.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the WMAT Tribal Utility to evaluate the sewer line problems Ms. Elaine Ethelbah is experiencing at her home and to take appropriate action and make necessary repairs to Ms. Ethelbah's sewer lines to enable Ms. Ethelbah to return to living in her home without the problems she is currently experiencing.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
