**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Roads Committee is in receipt of the Federal Register, January 9, 2001, which allows "tribal capacity building funds" to be made available to tribal governments; and

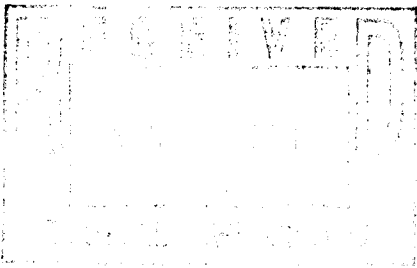
**WHEREAS**, this funding is made available to Tribes with the following stipulations:


1. Scope of work;
2. Budget;
3. Tribal resolution in support of the funding; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Roads Committee has reviewed the requirements and has agreed to comply with this request.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office secure funds for tribal capacity building as stated in the Federal Register dated January 9, 2001.

The foregoing resolution was on February 21, 2001 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
