RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal member Floyd Lupe has requested to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance in Hon-Dah; and

WHEREAS, the area he has identified is on the east side of the rodeo grounds in Hon-Dah; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lupe states that the Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance will be held in the latter part of September 2001.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to Mr. Floyd Lupe to the use area identified in Hon-Dah for the purpose of conducting an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance in late September 2001.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 22, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
