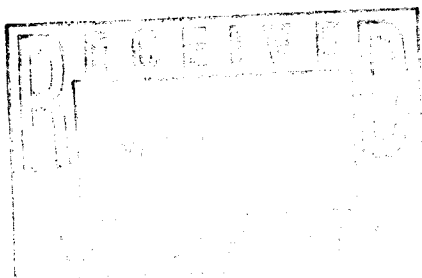


**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS**, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Permanent Land Restoration code states that a portion of the Permanent Land Restoration Fund be set aside for Scholarships and Internships for upper-level Tribal member college students pursuing a degree in Natural Resources or a related field; and
- WHEREAS**, the Permanent Land Restoration Board met, and reviewed and selected students for scholarship awards for the Spring semester 2001 on Friday, January 12, 2001; and
- WHEREAS**, the Permanent Land Restoration Board selected the following students for scholarship awards for the Spring semester of 2001: Colbert Burnette (Northern Arizona University, BS in Civil Engineering), Brando Pusher (Northern Arizona University, BS in Civil Engineering), Arnold Pailzote (University of Arizona, BS in Renewable Natural Resources), Sisto Hernandez (University of Arizona, BS in Animal Science), Cindy Burnette (University of Arizona, JD and PhD program in Environmental Law), Candy Lupe (Northern Arizona University, MS in Forestry), Jonathan Cody (Stanford University, MS in Fluid Mechanics and Hydrology), Cheryl Pailzote (University of Arizona, MS in Hydrology), and Doreen Gatewood (University of Arizona, MS in Renewable Natural Resources); and
- WHEREAS**, scholarship selections and the amount of each scholarship was based on meeting the guidelines outlined in the scholarship application, academic achievement, and financial need.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Tribal Permanent Land Restoration Board recipient selection of the above scholarship from the Land Restoration fund for the Spring semester of 2001.

The foregoing resolution was on February 28, 2001 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
