**WHEREAS,** Chagache Day Care Center (Center) staff have informed the Tribal Council of celebration plans for the 30-year anniversary of the Center; and

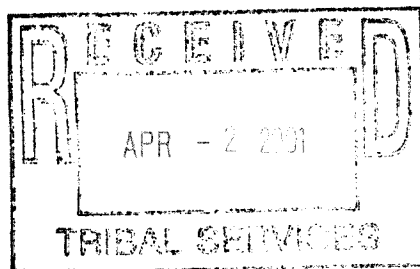
**WHEREAS,** plans include the Head Start Rodeo, Pow-Wow and a light parade to be held June 30<sup>th</sup> and July 1, 2001; and


**WHEREAS,** the Center staff have requested permission and support from the Tribal Council to hold the 30-year anniversary celebration on behalf of the Center.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and grants approval for the 30-year anniversary celebration for the Chagache Day Care Center to be held on June 30 and July 1, 2001.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Chagache Day Care Center staff to coordinate the parade plans with Arizona Department of Transportation and to invite Tribal royalty to the festivities

The foregoing resolution was on March 14, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
