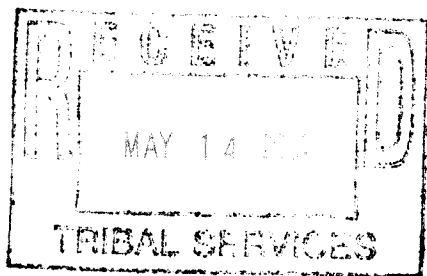
WHEREAS, this camp offers the youth positive experiences along with life skills training and education; and





BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Miss Indian World Kealoha May Cody Alo to help coordinate the barbecue.

The foregoing resolution was on April 30, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
