

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

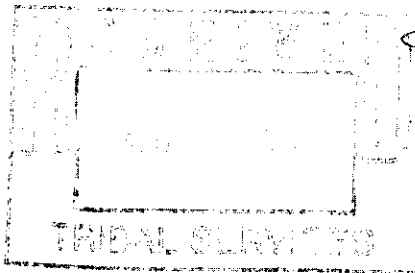
**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division has come before the Tribal Council this date and requested the approval for Management Bull Elk hunt clients to be able to upgrade their hunt from Management Bull to Trophy Bull status by paying an additional \$7,000 as long as there are sufficient unfilled trophy tags available; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council recognizes the need to meet harvest objectives in order to provide the best possible sustainable management of Tribal wildlife resources while at the same time, generating additional income for the Tribe; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council concludes that approval be granted for Management Bull Elk hunters to upgrade their tags to Trophy Bull Elk by paying an additional fee as long as tags are available.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission for Management Bull Elk hunters to upgrade their tags to Trophy Bull as long as the appropriate criteria are met.

The foregoing resolution was on July 28, 2001 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (f), (h), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
