

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Ms. Jaki Baha-Alchesay came before the Tribal Council this day and requested reinstatement to her position at Sunrise Park Resort, along with pay she would have earned in her position if she had worked a forty-hour work week from January 13, 2002 to February 14, 2002; and


WHEREAS, After discussing with Jaki Baha-Alchesay the reasons for her termination and the manner in which it was conducted, the Tribal Council finds merit in having Ms. Baha-Alchesay return to her position at Sunrise Park Resort with full back pay for her salary at a normal forty-hour work week for January 13, 2002 to February 14, 2002.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the General Manager of Sunrise Park Resort to reinstate Ms. Jaki Baha-Alchesay to the position and salary she held prior to her termination with entitlement to receive her standard rate of pay for a forty-hour week from January 13, 2002 to February 14, 2002, the time from her termination to this decision.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
