

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Transportation Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century provides significant funding for road construction on Indian Reservations; and

**WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs has been designated as the agency to administer these funds for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and


**WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office has provided the Tribe a Notice of Funding Availability for Fiscal Year 2002 of 2% Tribal Transportation Planning Funds; and


**WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to notify the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office of its intent to apply for this funding in the amount of \$125,000.00 to perform a mass transit study on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to identify efficient means for effective community transportation means on the Reservation; and

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Transportation Planner to provide a (1) Scope of Work, (2) Detailed Budget not to exceed \$125,000.00, and (3) Official Tribal Resolution to the Bureau of Indian Affairs necessary to secure the \$125,000.00 2% Planning funds for the Tribal Transportation Transit study identified above.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman or other duly authorized representative to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 21, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
