

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Highway Safety Act of 1966, U.S.C. Title 23, Section 402, provides U.S. Department of Transportation Funds to assist tribes in financing highway traffic safety projects; and

**WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to receive funding adequate to finance the following:

1. Data collection;
2. Traffic records;
3. Police traffic services; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council believes the Transportation Planner is best suited to submit a completed detailed budget, summary of crash data, drug certification and measurable intended goals established by the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Council desires that this proposal be submitted to the Office of Indian Highway Safety as soon as possible but not later than June 1, 2002.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby notifies the Bureau of Indian Affairs, of its intent to make application for the available funds offered by the Highway Safety Act of 1966, U.S.C. Title 23, Section 402.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Transportation Planner to submit a complete detailed budget summary of crash data, drug certification and measurable intended goals of the Tribe to the Indian Highway Safety Office as soon as possible but no later than June 1, 2002.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman or other duly authorized representative, to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 21, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

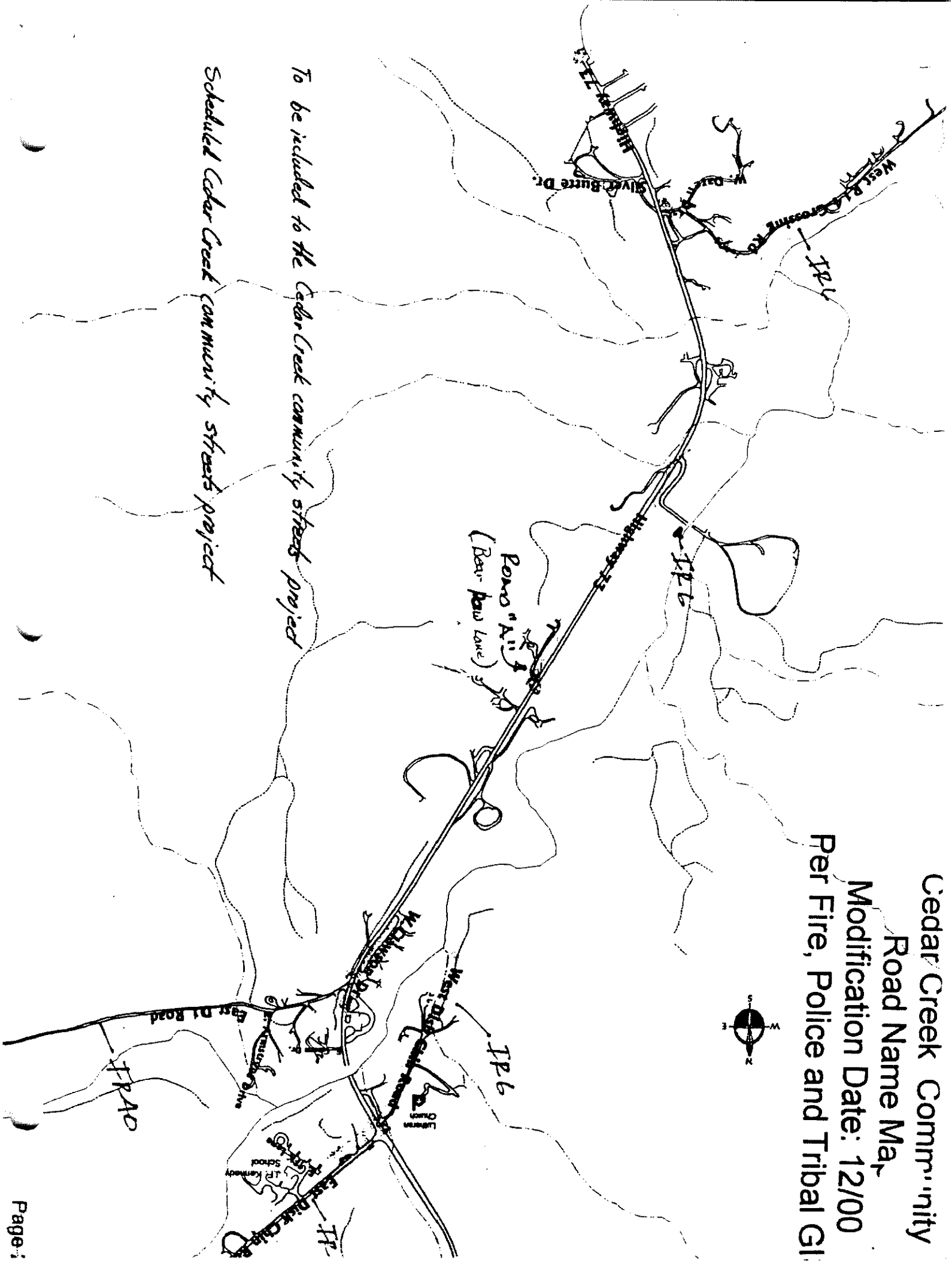


# Cedar Creek Community
