

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, The Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century provides significant money for road construction on Indian Reservations; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has been designated as the agency to administer these funds for the Tribes; and

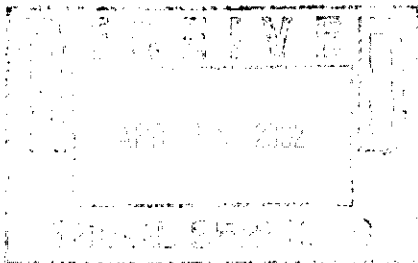
WHEREAS, the Branch of Roads, Western Regional Office, has identified additional monies for construction; and

WHEREAS, because of increased motor vehicle traffic in the community, there is an immediate need for a concrete walkway to help ensure the safety of school children walking to Canyon Day Elementary school along West Street in the Canyon Day community.


BE IT RESOLVED, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the BIA Western Regional office to allocate construction monies for and facilitate the Tribe's request to widen West street and construct safe and adequate sidewalks on West street for pedestrian traffic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it grants a gratuitous right-of-way as identified in the attached grant necessary to complete this project.

The foregoing resolution was on March 21, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of Seven for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b),(h) (j) (t) and (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
