

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Cibecue school has had the opportunity to provide Tae Kwon Do Training for school students through the Tae Kwon Do Training Association located in Phoenix, and managed by citizens from the country of South Korea; and

WHEREAS, through this relationship, members of the Cibecue school board visited South Korea in early May 2002 to foster goodwill and establish links between representatives in South Korea and the Tribe; and

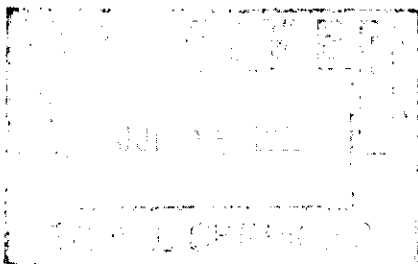
WHEREAS, the Cibecue School Board has invited representatives from South Korea to attend festivities to be held in Cibecue in August, and to include programs and training in Tae Kwon Do; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports this international exchange of goodwill and recognizes the value of the Taek Won Do program for strengthening self esteem and physical education for its youth.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses and welcomes the planned August visit by the delegation from South Korea to Cibecue, and to the Cibecue school, to promote international understanding and provide additional cultural resources for our Cibecue youth.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby welcomes the delegation from South Korea for their August visit and asks that all communities within the Reservation make efforts to ensure the visitors feel welcomed during their stay.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 5, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
