

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the N'dee Bii Fitness Center has joined the Apache Diabetes Wellness Program under the White Mountain Apache Division of Health Programs 16 months ago; and

WHEREAS, the N'dee Bii Fitness Center is quickly becoming a premiere health and fitness facility which offers a wide variety of exercise programs, health education, and health screenings to the White Mountain Apache People; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Apache Diabetes Wellness Program and the N'dee Bii Fitness Center are joined together to combat health problems associated with diabetes, as well as prevention and delaying the onset of diabetes; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with the purpose, it has become necessary for the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Apache Diabetes Wellness Program / N'dee Bii Fitness Center to seek an alternative Fitness Center Building for all concerns related to health and safety of participants and staff; and

WHEREAS, the Apache Diabetes Wellness Program / N'dee Bii Fitness Center requests permission of the Tribal Council that it be re-assigned to occupy and manage the Whiteriver Theater and the pool facility which will enhance fitness opportunities for all Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Theater and pool facility would meet all program requirements for size and central access for all needs and Special Diabetes Funds would allow for building renovation on a level floor, ventilation, electrical, plumbing, and other construction for offices and classroom spaces.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the re-assignment to the Apache Diabetes Wellness Program / N'dee Bii Fitness Center from Alchesay Hall to the Whiteriver Theater and the Tribal pool facility.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Apache Diabetes Wellness Program / N'dee Bii Fitness Center immediately implement a plan for building renovation and take action guaranteed to assume responsibility of the Whiteriver Theater and pool facility as grant funding permits.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by

the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
