## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Community of Cibecue is planning celebrations and events during the upcoming 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday; and
- WHEREAS, representatives from the community have described for the Council the special events organized for each day during the holiday period from July 3 through July 6, 2002; and
- WHEREAS, these events will include picnics, concerts, and sports activities; and
- WHEREAS, the goal of these activities is to build community harmony, and promote healthy and safe activities to commemorate the holiday; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports these activities and commends the members of the community for undertaking and preparing these events; and
- WHEREAS, the members of the community have asked for endorsement from the Council as a sign of support for these planned activities.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recognizes and endorses the 4<sup>th</sup> of July activities to be held July 3 through 6 by the Community of Cibecue.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 5, 2002</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
