

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** tribal member Stacy Dora Loring, dob: August 14, 1979, daughter of Sylvester Duke & Lolita (Classay) Loring, has requested that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that she may become eligible for enrollment with the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community; and

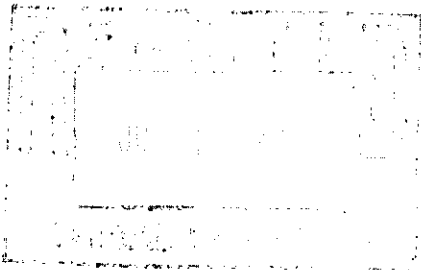
**WHEREAS,** the necessary documents of relinquishment of head rights was signed by Stacy Dora Loring in the presence of a Notary Public on the 17th day of June 2002, which are attached hereto; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Enrollment Committee approved this relinquishment request at their meeting on June 27, 2002.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Stacy Dora Loring and her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is relinquished, along with any and all privileges accorded members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe such as, but not limited to: hunting, fishing, and recreational privileges upon the White Mountain Apache Indian Reservation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Stacy Dora Loring from the membership rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article II, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
