

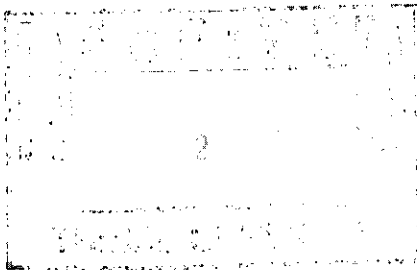
**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Mr. Winston Tortice came before the Tribal Council this day and requested reinstatement to his position at the Whiteriver Police Department, along with pay he would have earned in his position if he had worked a forty-hour work week from July 1 to July 12, 2002; and


WHEREAS, After discussing with Winston Tortice the reason for his termination, the Tribal Council finds merit in having Mr. Tortice return to his position at the Whiteriver Police Department with full back pay for his salary at a normal forty-hour work week for July 1 to July 12, 2002.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reinstates Mr. Winston Tortice to the position and salary he held prior to his termination with entitlement to receive his standard rate of pay for a forty-hour week from July 1 to July 12, 2002.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
