

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

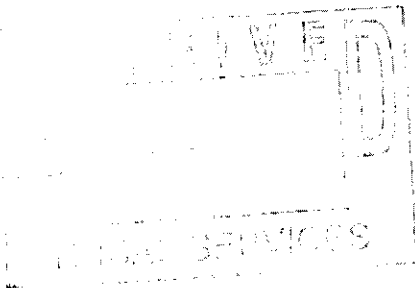
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has met today to learn of the economic losses and impacts of the Rodeo-Chediski Fire Complex experienced by the tribe; and


WHEREAS, FATCO Manager, and Board Members referenced FATCO's financial losses and recommended that the Tribal Council invite congressional delegates to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires the opportunity to meet with the congressional delegation to encourage federal funding for the Tribe's fire recovery efforts.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Chairman contact the congressional delegation to encourage their visit to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation so the Tribal Council can pursue funding for fire recovery efforts for Rodeo-Chediski fire.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
