

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has received information from Councilman Jacob Henry on a proposal from International Sun Prints to donate five hundred printed tee-shirts to the Cibecue community to sell and realize income after the devastating impact of the Rodeo-Chediski fire complex; and

WHEREAS, International Sun Prints also desires to donate school supplies and bags for Cibecue school children who are going to return to school in the midst of the negative financial impact to Cibecue during the Rodeo-Chediski fire.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the donation of five hundred printed tee-shirts for resale to enable the community of Cibecue to receive monetary assistance after the devastating impact of the Rodeo-Chediski fire complex and that it directs Councilmen Jacob Henry and Ronnie Lupe to authorize the sale and disbursement of proceeds from those sales of the printed tee-shirts to members of the Cibecue community in need as a result of the Rodeo-Chediski fire complex.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the donation of school supplies and school backpacks from International Sun Prints and authorizes Councilmen Jacob Henry and Ronnie Lupe to distribute the school supplies and school backpacks to children in need in Cibecue as a result of the Rodeo-Chediski fire complex.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
