

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribe has been awarded an Indian Community Development Block Grant with sufficient funds to construct Cibecue Community Building and Feeding Center; and

WHEREAS, constructing such facilities meets an essential community development need by providing space so that services critical to orderly community development can be provided; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has solicited bids from three firms who provide soil testing services; and


WHEREAS, the Tribe selected the low bid of \$2,750.00 from Speedie and Associates to perform the necessary soil testing for the Cibecue Community Building and Feeding Center.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to sign an agreement approved through the Legal Department that authorizes Speedie and Associates to perform the necessary soil testing for construction of the Cibecue Community Building and the Feeding Center.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
