



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** as set forth in Resolution No. 07-2002-173, the Department of Interior's Emergency Stabilization and Rehabilitation Team has identified specifications for rehabilitation and stabilization treatments of the natural resources on Trust lands, which will take approximately three years to complete, and allocated funding for an Implementation Leader of the Burned Area Emergency Rehabilitation Team; and
- WHEREAS,** as set forth in Resolution No. 07-2002-173, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has reviewed the job description for the Implementation Leader, attached to that resolution, and has resolved that "equivalent experience" should be added to the qualifications to substitute for some of the technical expertise required; and
- WHEREAS,** if candidates meet the job description requirements, a Committee appointed by the Tribal Personnel Department will review the applications of the finalists and select the Implementation Leader; and
- WHEREAS,** as set forth in Resolution No. 07-2002-173, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested a P.L. 93-638 cooperative agreement between the Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, for the position of Implementation Leader; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has determined that the job should be advertised publicly for five days.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Tribe Personnel Department shall publicly advertise the position of Implementation Leader for five days.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (c), (g), (i), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
