

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has reviewed the Enterprise Budgets for Fiscal Year 2002-2003; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has decided upon necessary adjustments to the proposed Enterprise Budgets; and

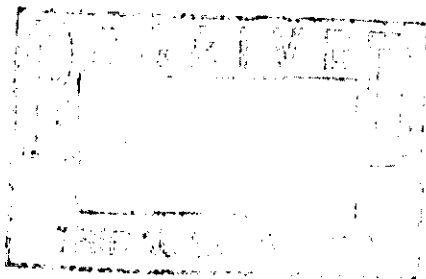
**WHEREAS,** the Enterprise Budgets, with the recommended adjustments, are ready for immediate implementation; and

**WHEREAS,** the Enterprise Capital Budget will be prioritized by the Executive Enterprise Director for implementation subject to the Tribe's cash flow.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Enterprise Operating Budgets with total income of \$102,383,191.00 and total expense of \$91,127,172.00, resulting in total net income of \$11,256,019.00 and the Enterprise Capital Budgets totaling \$3,856,707.00. Detail by Enterprise is shown on Attachments A and B, respectively.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Budget Committee to provide the Tribal Council with quarterly reports on the status of each Enterprise's budget.

The foregoing resolution was on September 16, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
