RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- **WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Police Department is working to establish a system to maintain reservation-wide traffic records; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Police Department needs computer software and hardware to adequately manage this comprehensive records program; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Police Department is seeking funding in the amount of \$20,200.00 as a grant from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to pay for the hardware and software.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the grant request to be submitted by the Police Department for \$20,200.00 from the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the traffic records computer hardware and software.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this Resolution does not authorize the release of traffic records to outside agencies, but such policy shall be reviewed by the Council at a later date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 23, 2002</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
