FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

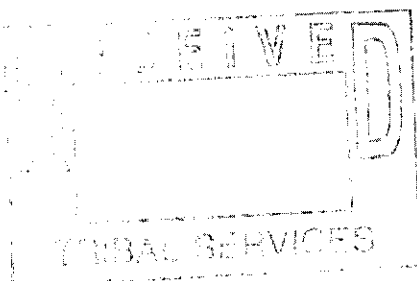
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that Raymond Kayona, a non-tribal member has passed away; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kayona has lived the last fifteen years in Hondah; and

WHEREAS, Richard Palmer, nephew of Mr. Kayona, has requested the Tribe permit Mr. Kayona's burial on the White Mountain Apache Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends its sincere sympathies to the family and grants approval for Mr. Kayona's burial on the White Mountain Apache Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on September 23, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (e), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
