

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the National Renewable Energy Laboratory has a program for loaning anemometers to Indian tribes for a period of one year; and


WHEREAS, the Laboratory has made an anemometer and forty meter tower available to the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to obtain more information about the wind source on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, an initial site for installing the anemometer on the west side of the intersection of Highway 260 and the Sunrise Road has been selected by the Tribal Engineering Department.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to allow the anemometer to be installed on the west side of the intersection of Highway 260 and the Sunrise Road and further agrees that the records obtained by this anemometer may be shared as public information with the National Renewable Energy Laboratory.

The foregoing resolution was on November 27, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
