

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Mr. Roger Lupe, Sr. came before the Tribal Council this day to seek reinstatement to his position as Maintenance Supervisor with the Sunrise Ski Park and Resort, in addition to his request for back-pay of the salary he would have earned from the day of his lay-off to this day in accordance with his regular work schedule and salary; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council cautions Mr. Lupe to ensure his receipt of any back-pay is obtained in coordination with any applicable reporting requirements and law should he have received federal or state economic assistance during the time of his unemployment.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the General Manager of the Sunrise Ski Park and Resort to reinstate Roger Lupe, Sr. to his position as held prior to his lay-off on June 12, 2002 and to provide Mr. Lupe with payment for the wages he would have earned from the date of his lay-off to the date of this Resolution, in accordance with his scheduled salary and work hours which in no event shall exceed forty hours per week.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for, ZERO against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i) (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
