## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Marilyn Fall has met with the Tribal Council in executive session today; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Fall and her family currently reside in an Apache Dawn home in McNary; and
- **WHEREAS**, due to personal, safety and sensitive issues pertaining to her family, Ms. Fall has requested that her family be issued an Apache Dawn home in Hondah.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby advises Housing Authority to place her at the top of the priority list for the Apache Dawn housing area in Hondah.

The foregoing resolution was on March 5, 2003, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
