

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal member Ernestine Bancroft has reported to the Council that her home has been repossessed, and she is in urgent need of immediate housing for herself and her two twin children who are suffering from health problems; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bancroft seeks a smaller home than the home she recently had repossessed, in order to reduce the monthly rental now she would be obligated to pay; and

WHEREAS, due to the health complications of her two twin boys, she would like a location near to the Whiteriver hospital, with preference for the Knots Landing location.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the request of Tribal member Ernestine Bancroft for a home near the Whiteriver hospital and that she placed on top of the priority list for this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on March 19, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
