RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, pursuant to its lease with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Cellular One utilizes three sites on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to maintain its cellular telephone equipment; and
- WHEREAS, Cellular One advises that in addition to the sites currently maintained at Cooley Mountain, Seven Mile Hill, and Cibecue, they would like to include a second site in the vicinity of Cibecue, which will provide additional coverage in this area; and
- WHEREAS, Cellular One advises that they will either install their equipment on an existing site and tower, or on a new tower, which Cellular One would maintain; and
- WHEREAS, Cellular One requests that their current lease with the Tribe be modified to include the additional cellular site in the Cibecue vicinity, which site would subject to all terms and conditions in the lease; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered this request, and recognizes the benefits cellular phone service provides, not only to the public and its safety, but also the economic benefits to the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe concurs with this request, provided that Cellular One comply with all requirements of the Tribal Plan & Project Review (TPPR) process.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants and approves a lease addendum, in the form attached hereto, to the current Cellular One lease, to include one additional site in the vicinity of the Cibecue community, which site will be subject to all terms and conditions of said lease.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Cellular One is directed to comply with the requirements of the Tribal Plan and Project Review (TPPR) process.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence the Vice Chairman, or other duly authorized representative, to execute any documents necessary to carry out the purpose of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 23, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
