RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has received the request of Councilman Jacob Henry this day for authorization of reimbursement to members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Juanita Holmes of San Carlos who have assisted in two events for the community of Cibecue; and
- WHEREAS, Councilman Henry has requested use of \$2,500 of the \$5,000 donation from the Ho-Chunk Nation provided to the Tribe for recovery after the Rodeo-Chediski Fire Complex to fund the reimbursement described herein; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Council desires to provide a proper accounting for use of donated funds and determines that an itemized list of reimbursable expenses should be provided to the Tribal Controller prior to disbursement of donation funds.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that it hereby authorizes the disbursement of up to \$2,500 from the \$5,000 which the Ho-Chunk Nation donated to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for recovery efforts after the Rodeo-Chediski Fire Complex, provided that a proper accounting and itemized list of reimbursable expenses is provided to and approved through the Tribal Controller prior to disbursement of donated funds.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
