

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

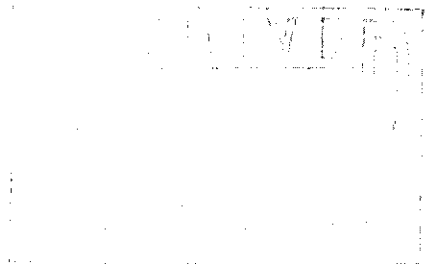
WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has received the request of Councilman Jacob Henry this day for the Tribal Council's authorization to appropriate \$5,000 to each community president within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, solely and expressly to fund community fire recovery related activities with such funding coming from the Rodeo-Chediski Fire Complex Donation Fund; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council determines that each community president, from Cibecue to McNary, shall be responsible for providing the Tribal Controller a list of proposed activities and projects planned for utilization of the approved funding and shall also provide the Tribal Controller detailed accounting forms and justification for expenditure of the allocated funds; and


WHEREAS, the Council desires to provide a proper accounting for use of donated funds and determines that an itemized list of reimbursable expenses should be provided the Tribal Controller prior to disbursement of donation funds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that it hereby authorizes the disbursement of up to \$5,000 to each community president within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, expressly and solely for use in activities within their community related to fire recovery and education, provided that a proper accounting and itemized list of projected reimbursable expenses is provided to and approved through the Tribal Controller prior to disbursement of donated funds.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
