## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Linda Holden and Eliza Lupe have come before the Tribal Council this date regarding the Queen Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that the two employees have been denied the use of administrative leave when serving in a chaperone/escort capacity; and
- WHEREAS, after discussion of the issue brought forth, determination was made that the Tribal employees will be authorized to use administrative leave when authorized to escort Miss White Mountain Apache Queen; and
- WHEREAS, the two Tribal employees shall have their annual leave hours restored retroactive to the date when the current Miss White Mountain Apache Queen received this title.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes use of Administrative Leave for Ms. Linda Holden and Ms. Eliza Lupe when serving in chaperone/escort function with Miss White Mountain Apache Queen, and it hereby directs the Human Resources Department to restore annual leave hours used by the two for their time used as escort/chaperone of Miss White Mountain Queen retroactive back to the date the current Queen's title was received.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 2003 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
