RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has always been concerned about the administration of education on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Education Office Agency Board has not been able to hold meetings due to a lack of a quorum at scheduled meetings; and
- WHEREAS, this lack of a quorum hinders required documents and reports from being approved by the Agency Board and for that reason the Tribal Council makes the following appointments to the Board effective this date.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that John F. Kennedy Day School Board serves as the Fort Apache Education Office Board, with at-large members from each Theodore Roosevelt School (Paul Declay, Sr.), Cibecue Community School (Kandi Burnette) and the Indian Education Committee (Colleen Faden throughout this summer.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 11, 2003</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>TWO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
