

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has received a request from the British Broadcasting Corporation, through its Natural History Unit, to film a brief educational video of the Tribe's grey wolf release program for broadcast to viewers in the United Kingdom and across Europe in children's educational program entitled "The Really Wild Show;" and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that any filming conducted on the Fort Apache Reservation must have council approval and must also be conducted in accordance with applicable laws and polices of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised through the British Broadcast Corporation that the footage it films on the Fort Apache Reservation, while present from July 29, 2003 to August 2, 2003, for broadcast thereafter will never be utilized outside of the Really Wild Show, nor for any purpose other than educational purposes focused on discussions of wolf biology, breeding, reintroduction into the wild, the efforts of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in assisting with reintroduction of the grey wolves and the importance of the wolves to the White Mountain Apache people and culture; and

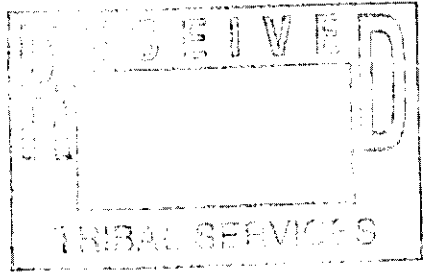
WHEREAS, available members of the Tribal Council have received a briefing from Krista Beazley, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Wolf Program coordinator on the benefits of this filming project to her program and to the Tribe in general, and based thereon the Tribal Council finds this filming to be in the best interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the British Broadcasting Corporation representatives Katja Anton, Nick Baker, Sean Miller Scott Tibbles, and Roger Webb to enter the Fort Apache Indian Reservation from July 29, 2003 to August 2, 2003 at midnight to film an educational documentary of approximately 6 minutes in length for inclusion and broadcast within the Really Wild Show, which the Tribal Council understands is broadcast to six million viewers in the United Kingdom and approximately 5 million viewers across Europe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it intends that the British Broadcasting Corporation's (BBC) presence on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation shall be governed and administered in strict accordance with the terms of the "Temporary Permit to Film within the Exterior Boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation" between the BBC and the Tribe, which is approved herein.

The foregoing resolution was on 7/29/03 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30,

1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

"THE REALLY WILD SHOW" ARIZONA FILMING TRIP - 2003

The Really Wild Show is a children's wildlife education programme, produced by the BBC's Natural History. It is aimed primarily at 8-14 year olds and is the most popular and long running programme of its kind here in the UK. Now on its nineteenth series, The Really Wild Show reaches audiences of over 6 million viewers in the UK on BBC1. It is also broadcast to 5 million homes throughout Europe (on the BBC Prime Channel), before going international. In each series there are twelve, thirty minute programmes consisting of short films which aim to show a variety of wildlife stories from around the world in order to educate our young audience about those places, their unique culture and their fauna/flora.

We would be extremely interested to feature a short film (~6mins) on the grey wolves which have recently been release on your reserve. The film would include their biology, the importance of the breeding and re-introduction into the wild, the current good research and work you are doing with Krista Beazley as our guide, and also the importance of the species to your Indian culture present and past, possibly illustrated in song. We have great admiration and respect for the work you are doing. We are keen to treat everything we film authentically, especially where the scared wolf song is concerned. The sole purpose of this trip is to educate our young audience about the nature and culture found there - hopefully one day this will make a difference in terms of world conservation. The film would then be broadcast in our next series being broadcast in Summer 2004.

Although we are a very popular TV programme, we produce for public service broadcast and are therefore a non-profit, non-commercial show. The budgets we work with are very small and the purpose is to educate. However we would be happy to offer the Tribe a donation of \$150 in cash, some BBC pens for the children for school, and a few copies of the show to use for educational purposes.


We would like to come and film with you for 1, maybe 2 days around the 29th July 2003. The film crew consist of 5 people – Katja Anton, Nick Baker, Sean Miller, Scott Tibbles, and Roger Webb. We are a small crew with limited amount of equipment so as not to disrupt the place we visit. The crew are all employed and insured by the BBC, which is responsible for all expenses they incur and their return flight to the UK, with all the equipment. The BBC will be liable for all legal claims for personal injury and damage to property if caused by the BBC's negligence arising from our filming activities (costs will be covered if anyone gets hurt).

The Show boasts a history of awards, which hopefully will illustrate the kind of work we do; listed below are the most recent:

**TEMPORARY PERMIT TO FILM WITHIN THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES OF THE FORT
APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

The White Mountain Apache Tribe (hereinafter, "WMAT"), the White Mountain Apache Tribe Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division (hereinafter, "WORD") and the British Broadcasting Corporation, its officers, employees, agents, assigns, and successors (hereinafter collectively referred to as "BBC") of BBC Natural History Unit, Whiteladies Road Bristol, BS82LR, United Kingdom, do hereby agree as follows:

1. IDENTIFICATION OF WMAT & WORD

3. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to permit BBC, specifically the Really Wild Show film crew which consists of five (5) people - Katja Anton, Nick Baker, Sean Miller, Scott Tibbles and Roger Webb - to have access to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to film a short (approximately 6 minutes in length) film (hereinafter referred to as VIDEO) about the White Mountain Apache Tribe's gray wolf release program. It is the intent of BBC to broadcast this short film during its Summer 2004 broadcast of The Really Wild Show to approximately six million viewers in the United Kingdom and approximately five million viewers across Europe. The purpose of VIDEO is to educate viewers about the White Mountain Apache Tribe's gray wolf release program, including wolf biology, breeding, reintroduction into the wild, the Tribe's current research regarding grey wolves, and the importance of the gray wolf to the White Mountain Apache. The VIDEO's purpose is also to educate viewers about the places and culture of the White Mountain Apache people.

4. TERM

This Permit Agreement shall begin On July 29, 2003 and shall terminate no later than August 2, 2003.

5. TIME

Time limits stated in this Agreement are of the essence of the Agreement.

6. CONDITIONS

A. WMAT will permit BBC, from July 29, 2003 to August 2, 2003, the opportunity to enter upon, conduct, and film VIDEO within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

B. BBC shall include in VIDEO the following information:

6. The terrain and history of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and the White Mountain Apache Tribe's commitment to act as a careful and prudent steward of its natural resources.

7. The fishing, hunting, hiking, camping, canyoneering, river-running, skiing, gaming, and sight-seeing opportunities within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The WMAT and WORD hereby provide BBC authorization to film footage of the items listed above.

C. Generally, the WMAT and WORD require a minimum permit fee of \$5,000 for filming activities conducted on the Reservation. However, given the educational premise of VIDEO and the promise of BBC to provide WORD with no less than 1 master copy of VIDEO along with 10 copies of VIDEO for WORD's use, WMAT and WORD will waive the applicable permit fee.

D. BBC shall utilize a WORD representative, Krista Beazely, for guidance and information during filming of VIDEO.

E. BBC shall always remain in the company of the WORD representative during filming of any type while within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BBC shall provide WORD and WMAT one master tape of VIDEO no later than ~~November 30, 2003~~, or prior to any broadcast, sale or distribution of VIDEO in any format, whichever date comes first, to enable WMAT and WORD to suggest any deletions or additions to VIDEO before its broadcast or distribution. Each master tape of VIDEO shall be professionally edited and narrated, and shall contain

appropriate music. Each master tape of VIDEO must be of a quality comparable to, or exceeding, current professional documentaries for broadcast to the general public.

- G. BBC hereby agrees to broadcast VIDEO in the summer of 2004 or prior thereto.
- H. BBC shall not edit or manipulate VIDEO for any other broadcast other than that approved herein, specifically the Really Wild Show.
- I. BBC agrees to the following requirements as a condition of entry to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation:
1. BBC shall not commit waste upon lands within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and BBC shall, at its own expense, within five days of completion of use of all lands, repair any damage caused by BBC, and return all areas to their original condition existing immediately prior to the time BBC's use and entry of the area began, to the extent reasonably possible. To prevent excess expense and delay to the parties to this permit agreement, BBC, the WMAT and WORD hereby agree that if BBC commits waste of any nature which BBC fails to remedy as described herein, BBC shall, as liquidated damages, remit to WMAT no less than \$250 for each day such waste is not repaired in excess of five calendar days.
 2. BBC agrees to compensate the WMAT or individual Member(s) thereof for any direct or consequential damages to lands on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and improvements, if any, on those lands that result from the filming and/or activity.
 3. BBC agrees to give preferential employment and/or assignment, if possible, to members of the WMAT during such portions of the project that are conducted on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation. Enrolled WMAT members' income paid by BBC for on-Reservation employment shall be exempt from State withholding taxes.
 4. Any use of helicopters or other aircraft within the airspace of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation shall only be permitted with written authorization from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, shall be governed by Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) regulations and shall, as a guideline, comply with the National Forest regulations regarding helicopter flights over national forest land.
 5. BBC shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations and ordinances and BBC hereby acknowledges that this permit to enter and use the lands of the WMAT as described herein is conditioned on its officers', employees', agents', assigns', and successors' obedience of WMAT laws and regulations and that violation of any applicable law and regulation makes BBC

trespassers, subject to arrest, tribal and federal court action, expulsion from the Reservation, and seizure of personal property as security for payment of potential obligations to the WMAT. BBC further agrees to be bound by the liquidated damages provision of WMAT law if found liable for any violation.

6. BBC agrees that artifacts of a historical, religious or ceremonial nature covered in the Federal Archaeological Preservation Act and the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act shall not be filmed in VIDEO nor taken from the Reservation nor disturbed in any manner.

7. COPYRIGHT

All right, title and interest of any kind to all footage of lands, infrastructure and resources within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation may remain solely in BBC, provided that VIDEO shall not be broadcast or utilized outside of the BBC Really Wild Show nor utilized in any means other than an educational broadcast on the Really Wild Show.

8. INSURANCE

- 8.1 BBC shall purchase from and maintain in a company or companies lawfully authorized to do business in the jurisdiction in which this Agreement is executed, insurance for protection from claims, under workers' or workmen's compensation acts and other employee benefit acts which are applicable, for damages because of bodily injury, including death. Certificates of such insurance shall be filed with WMAT prior to the commencement of the work described herein.
- 8.2 Prior to commencing work pursuant to this Agreement, BBC shall provide to WMAT evidence of General Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance including vehicle coverage issued to BBC and insurance coverage protecting BBC from all claims for personal injury, including death, and all claims for destruction of or damage to property, arising out of or in connection with any operations under this Agreement, whether such operations are by BBC or by any subcontractor employed by BBC or anyone directly or indirectly employed by BBC or a subcontractor employed by BBC or its assignee. Insurance shall be written with a limit of liability of not less than \$1,000,000 for all damages arising out of bodily injury, including death, at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any one person in any one accident; and a limit of liability of not less than \$1,000,000 aggregate for any such damages sustained by two or more persons in any one accident. Insurance shall be written with a limit of liability of not less than \$1,000,000 for all property damage sustained by any one person in any one accident; and a limit of liability of not less than \$1,000,000 aggregate for any such damage sustained by two or more persons in any one accident. BBC shall ensure that each policy of public liability or property damage insurance carried by BBC shall name WMAT as an additional insured.

- 8.3 BBC may select its insurance company, however, such insurance company shall be and must remain authorized to do business in the State of Arizona by, and be licensed by and in good standing with, the Arizona Department of Insurance. WMAT must be given thirty (30) days notice of cancellation, non-renewal, or any endorsements restricting or reducing coverage.
- 8.4 If any policy or contract of insurance required of BBC by this Agreement, including general liability insurance and worker's compensation insurance, is canceled, and BBC has not obtained a substitute policy or contract consistent with the provisions of this Agreement, then WMAT may either immediately terminate this Agreement, or WMAT may obtain such insurance with such limits and deductions, inclusions and exclusions, as it shall deem proper in its sole discretion and shall charge to BBC the cost thereof.

9. **INDEMNIFICATION**

BBC agrees to indemnify and hold the WMAT, WORD and their employees, subcontractors, agents and assigns free and harmless from and against all liabilities, losses, claims, liens, demands and causes of action of every kind and character occurring or in anyway incident to, or arising out of, the negligence, omission or other fault of BBC, its employees, subcontractors, agents and assigns pursuant to its activities under this Agreement. WMAT and WORD agree to indemnify and hold BBC and its employees, subcontractors, agents and assigns free and harmless from and against all liabilities, losses, claims, liens, demands and causes of action of every kind and character occurring or in anyway incident to, or arising out of, the negligence, omission or other fault of WMAT and WORD and their employees, subcontractors, agents and assigns pursuant to their activities under this Agreement. Such indemnities between BBC, WMAT and WORD, shall include not only any ultimate judgment, but any and all expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, incurred by the indemnified party directly related to any threatened or actual legal proceeding resulting from the negligent act or omission or other fault of the indemnifying party.

10. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK**


By granting the permission and privileges under this Agreement the WMAT and WORD make no representations as to the suitability or safety for the premises used pursuant to this Agreement, nor does WMAT and WORD verify BBC's compliance with applicable laws and regulations. BBC shall assume all risk and liability for damage and injury arising from, or related in any manner to, its activities within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

11. **GOVERNING LAW**


BBC hereby consents to the jurisdiction of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court as the

exclusive venue and forum for any claim arising from this Agreement or enforcement thereof. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws and regulations of the White Mountain Apache Tribe. Nothing within this Agreement shall waive the sovereign immunity of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
